- I. Prioritized plans for activating Community Outreach Ministry
 - A. Gospel Blitz
 - 1. Objectives
 - a. Share the Gospel in the Marketplace as Jesus commanded His disciples
 - b. Set up a canopy and sound system at specified locations or community events
 - i. Read and preach from the Bible
 - ii. Have volunteers around to talk/pray/share the Gospel with people
 - 2. Goals
 - a. Obedience to God's directive to GO
 - i. Mandate: Matthew 18:18-20, Matthew 10, Acts 17:16-34, 1 Corinthians 11:1, Romans 10:14-21
 - b. Meeting our responsibility that we are worthy to ask God to grow our numbers
 - 3. Needs
 - a. Sound system and power (solar generator and solar panels)
 - b. Lectern
 - c. Canopy
 - d. Volunteers to talk with, pray with, share the Gospel with people on request
 - e. New Believer Bibles and Gospel Tracts
 - 4. Next Steps
 - a. Call a meeting of potential volunteers
 - i. Seek key locations to set up on occasion EX: Stores, mall parking lots, local parks
 - 1). Ask attendees to contact businesses they have influence in to get permissions to set up on the street/parking lot in front of them
 - ii. Training on sharing the Gospel and/or using Tracts effectively

 - B. Men's Ministry using the masculine arts to bring men together
 - 1. Objectives
 - a. Help each other and those who need but cannot do or afford
 - b. Home, car and yard preventative maintenance and/or repairs
 - c. Cut, split and deliver firewood for elderly, widows and disabled
 - 2. Goals
 - a. Build relationships that will grow into accountability and mentoring
 - b. Encourage bringing boys 10-18 to join and mentor through doing
 - 3. Ultimate Goal
 - a. To build a formal program mentoring boys into responsible men of God
 - i. Start a Trail Life USA Troop (or similar)
 - ii. Trail Life USA
 - 4. Next Steps
 - a. Find one anointed leader of men and a small group of men to coordinate this effort
 - C. Local Disaster Response Preparedness
 - 1. Objectives
 - a. To assure that our churches are prepared to assist our community in the event of disaster
 - b. Set up a coordinated supply storage
 - 2. Next Steps
 - a. Survey churches on spaces, restroom/shower facilities, kitchen facitilies

- II. Plans for activating Pastoral Care/Connections
 - A. Monthly Pastors' Lunches
 - 1. A different church will host this lunch each month
 - a. Church will host it at their church
 - i. Will provide lunch, provide a short devotional to start, and any post-lunch activity

 - i. Allowing staff to meet association pastors and vice versa
 - c. Spend time getting to know each other in a church family atmosphere

 - b. Choose a day of the month to shoot for each month
 - c. Put calendar out for churches to choose when they want to commit

 - 1. Seeking ways for pastors to mentor youth
