Disaster Response SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

Introduction to Disaster Response

Participants who complete this required course will be credentialed to respond after disasters with Impact Disaster Response once discipline-specific training is completed. We will walk through a basic introduction of why and how we respond to disasters, how we work with partners, and what our incident command structure looks like.

Mass Feeding (Level 1)

Providing a hot meal is one thing. Providing 15,000 in one day requires planning. This training introduces how we pull it off, gives the basics of safe food handling, and introduces the many roles it takes to staff this kind of kitchen on wheels. Participants completing this course will be credentialed to serve with an Impact Disaster Response Mass Feeding team.

Clean Up (Level 1)

This course introduces Clean Up operations and how we ensure safety on every response. We'll cover flood clean up in a home, providing temporary roofing, and the basics of serving with a chainsaw team (actually operating a saw is a level 2 training). We'll also touch briefly on caring for homeowners as you work on their home. Participants who complete this course will be qualified to serve with an Impact Disaster Response clean up or rebuild team.

Administration (Level 1)

If you are good with a spreadsheet and multi-tasking details, this may be the team for you. This course will be a basic overview of the tasks and responsibilities of Administration Team members. Data collection and reporting will also be covered. Participants who complete the course will be prepared for Level 2 admin training or to deploy alongside an experienced team member.

Supply Distribution (Level 1)

This course introduces participants to a model for organizing and distributing donated supplies after a disaster that is both efficient for meeting physical needs and creates space for spiritual and emotional care. Practical tips as well as the reasoning behind particular practices will be discussed. Participants completing this course will be credentialed in Supply Distribution with Impact Disaster Response and ready to deploy with a team.
